	Dangerous Play	Prior training of participants by schools. Referee’s knowledge of rules and aware of dangerous play.	Referees to intervene and schools present to provide first aid if necessary. Serious injury, ambulance will be called	
	Slippery Surfaces Uneven Surfaces	Access to cleaning equipment at venue staff if required. Event manager to do a site check before training to identify any uneven surfaces. Inform athletes of hazard	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.	
	Poor technique of participant increasing risk of injury	Prior training of participants by schools.	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.	
	Players and officials tripping over items or people on sideline	Spectators asked to stay back from sideline Referees and coaches to ensure sideline remains clear.	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.	
	Players running/pushed into the wall along baseline	Preventative refereeing and adapted rules to reduce fouls occurring during the shot/lay-up.	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.	
	Athlete wearing inappropriate clothing / footwear	Relevant information communicated prior to event. Screening process as players take the court.	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.	
	Health issue related to condition or medication	Screening process by schools to determine suitability of athlete for sporting event Team Manager aware of	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.

	Athletes wandering out of the Stadium	Prior discussion by Manager/Coaches at schools and on the day. Establish boundaries during Team Managers Meeting. Team manager responsible for player checks/buddy system.	Schools present to provide first aid. Serious injury, ambulance will be called.	
	Fire/ Earthquake	Establish procedures during Team Managers Meeting RAMS set out with venue prior to event. Follow all procedures as set by venue.	MC to advise Clubs to assemble in designated assembly space outside stadium away from the fire danger. Team Managers to conduct roll call and keep players calm.	Burns, hit by falling objects. Panic
	Uninvited troublesome spectators	Clubs to have adequate coach/athlete ratio Clubs to have all groups of athletes adequately supervised at all times	Team Managers and court coordinator to be vigilant and to know where their students are at any one time. Event Manager to approach uninvited spectators to establish motive.	Harassment, bullying, fighting
